A permission note was sent home last week. Please sign and return it to your child's classroom teacher by Wednesday, 6 September.




Book Week is coming up once again! Students will engage with a range of books nominated for the prestigious CBCA awards through their weekly library lessons to celebrate Book Week.

Last week 19 students from our Primary choir travelled to Sydney to perform as part of a 500 member choir. We performed the 10 songs we have been rehearsing all year.


